

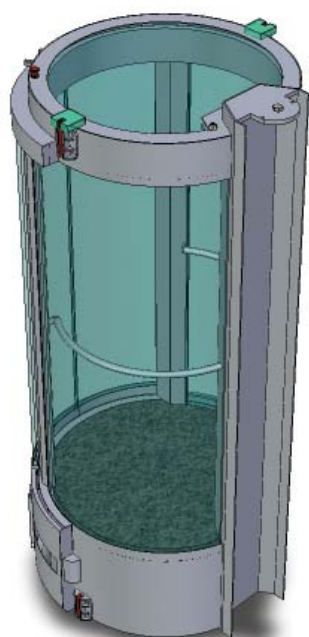

## Dual channel AIS receiver AIS400

The new AIS receiver, the AIS400, from Digital Yacht picks up signals from any vessel equipped with an AIS Class A or B transponder and sends the vessel's identity, position, course and speed over VHF frequencies. If you hook up an AIS receiver to a compatible plotter, you are able to see an overlay of nearby targets typically up to 20-30NM. The AIS400 has connections for both a regular chart plotter via NMEA and also a USB connection for a PC based plotter system such as Maxsea, Seapro, Maptech and Nobeltec.

The AIS400 incorporates its own GPS receiver and its target data is transmitted on two frequencies. It's a dual channel unit with two individual, highly sensitive receivers to ensure constant monitoring of targets.
